Entry conditions for project presentations

Who can apply?

Individuals, NGOs, foundations, associations and responsible bodies from school, non-formal and informal citizenship education can apply for participation in the project market. Educational projects, which are still in process may also apply. Projects should not be older than two years.

How to apply

Application is possible by the below fact sheet only. Please complete the attached fact sheet and send it to: nece-vienna2014@lab-concepts.de. Complementary material, such as documents, information brochures etc. may be added. Additional material may not exceed 2 MB. In case you submit photos (max. 5 pictures) or film material, please provide a link where the material can be accessed.

The deadline for submissions is 25 August 2014.

The most outstanding projects and approaches can present themselves at the project market of this year's NECE Conference in Vienna. Participants will be informed whether their project has been accepted by 5 September 2014. Projects and approaches, which cannot present their work in Vienna due to limited space are invited to present their work on the NECE Conference website.

The NECE Initiative cannot assume any costs for travel and accommodation. However, you may apply for an accommodation subsidy. Further information can be found here: http://bit.ly/1odxOsr. The NECE Initiative will provide all technical and other equipment for means of presentation as mentioned below.

Modes of presentation

Projects should be presented in a *Poster Session* (on display boards, one per project) and as *Audiovisual or Website Presentation* (laptop will be provided).

For the *Poster Session*, we ask you to prepare a presentation of your project/ approach on a poster in A3-format. In the *Audiovisual or Website Presentation*, you may choose to either present audiovisual material of your project or the project website. Additionally, you will have the opportunity to display material such as flyers or publications at your exhibition booth.



Presence at and opening hours of the project market

As the project market is intended as an exchange forum for presentation, networking, discussion and cooperation, please be prepared to present your project to the audience at the project market. The presentation will take place in the project market sessions on Friday, 17 October from 9-10 am, from 1.00-1.30 pm and from 3.30-4.00 pm. During these times, your exhibition booth must be hosted by you / the person presenting the project.

The project market will be opened on Friday, 17 October 2014. The set-up of the project market will take place on Thursday before the conference opening, the removal will be on Saturday (details will follow soon).
